Water Resources and the Effective Use of Water

The TMG is working with the central government and other authorities to develop water resources in order to provide urban activities and residents with greater reassurance against problems such as water shortages. TMG initiatives to develop water resources, which began with the construction of the Ogochi Dam on the Tamagawa River completed in 1957, are currently underway at the Yamba Dam.

In addition, to ensure the effective use of our precious water resources, guidance is provided to large building owners and developers to use reclaimed wastewater for purposes such as in toilet flush systems and rainwater, which normally flows into the sewer system, for sprinkling and other purposes.
